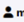

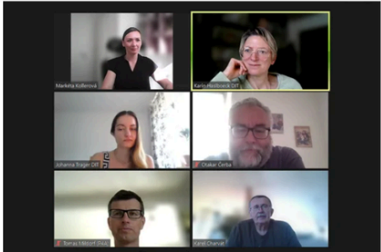

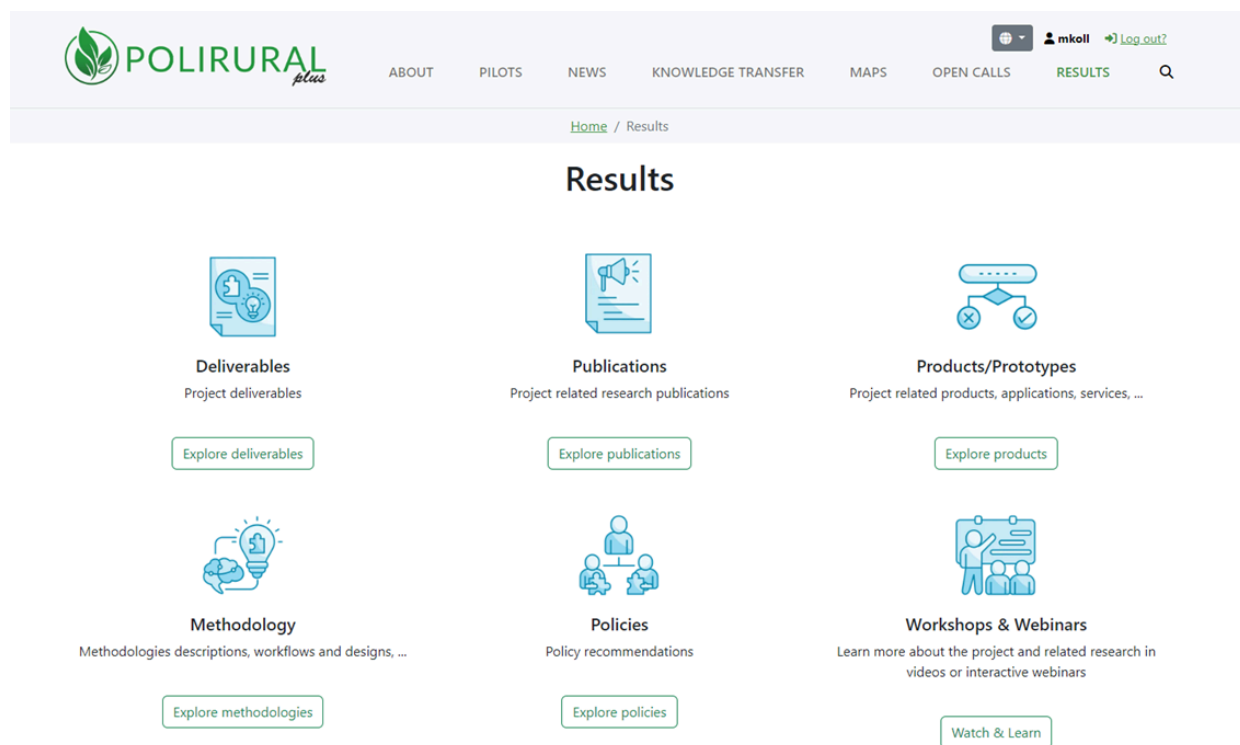


Figure 5 Results

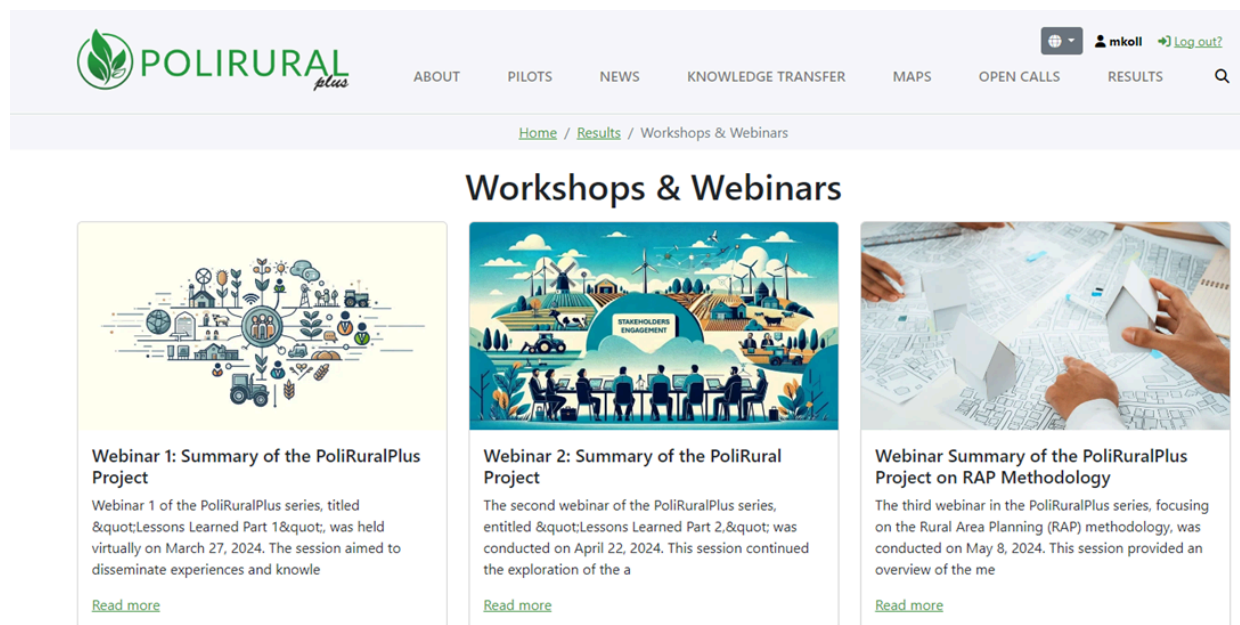


Figure 6 Project progress monitoring

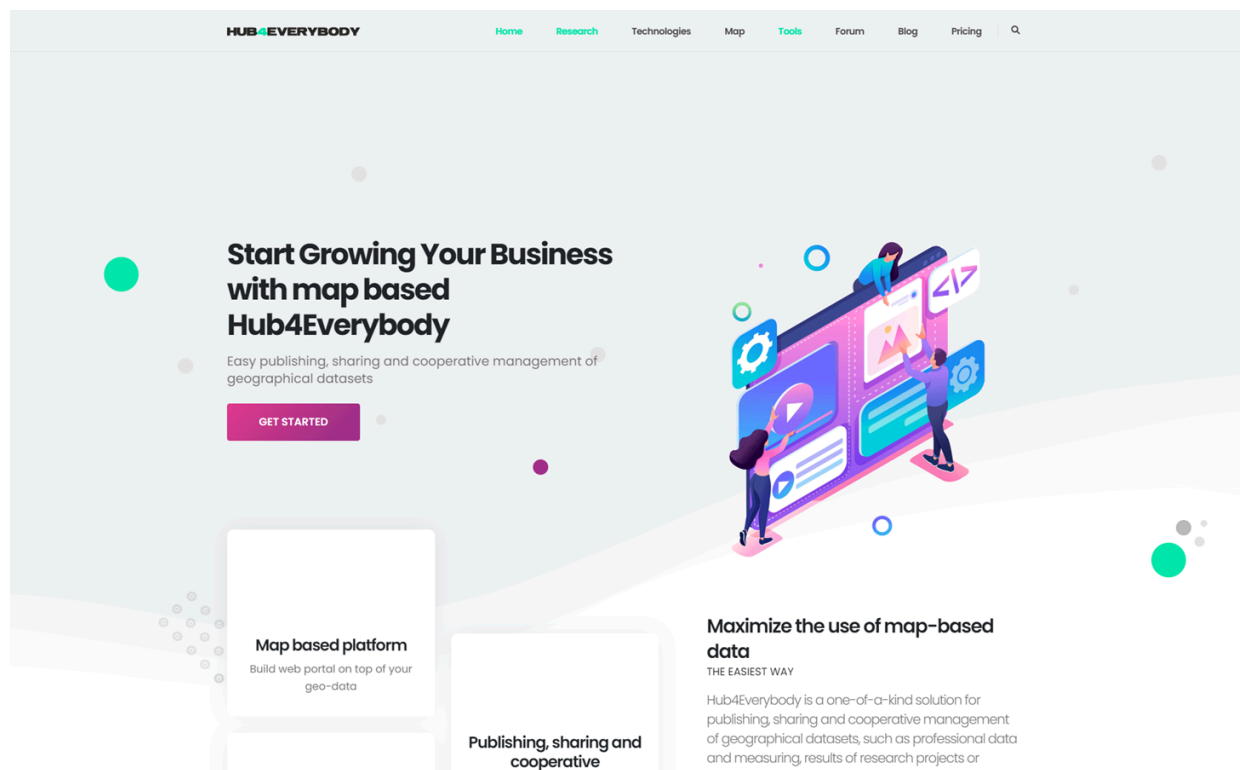


Figure 7 Hub4Everybody
